<b>8.</b>	<p><b>Any Other Business</b></p> <p>MCK updated the group on the Myplace scheme:</p> <p>This is a new strand of funding is being delivered by The Big Lottery on behalf of the Department for Children, Schools and Families (DCSF). This is not Lottery funding.</p> <p>Myplace is the capital element from <i>Aiming High</i>, which sets an ambition for new and improved places in all areas of the country over the next ten years. Capital grants of between £1m and £5m (from a total of £18m in the South east) are available to deliver</p>	

	<p>world-class youth facilities, driven by the active participation of young people and their views and needs, from idea inception to the management and running of the facilities when in place.</p> <p>All bids must demonstrate:</p> <p><b>active participation of young people; genuine cross sector partnerships; long term viability - myplace will not fund revenue costs</b></p> <p>All bids require top-tier authority (i.e. Hampshire County Council) endorsement and must be signed off by the Chief Executive Officer to be eligible.</p> <p>An advisory panel of staff from Children’s Services, Recreation &amp; Heritage and Economic Development departments will make recommendations about bids to the Chief Executive Officer, Andrew Smith, based on the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Does it meet Hampshire County Council priorities? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Hampshire Safer and more secure for all</li> <li>○ Maximising wellbeing</li> <li>○ Enhancing our quality of place</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Does the application demonstrate how the Youth Matters Outcomes will be addressed? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Things to do, places to go</li> <li>○ Opportunity to volunteer</li> <li>○ Info, advice and guidance</li> <li>○ Reforming targeted support</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Does it demonstrate <u>genuine</u> cross sector partnership?</li> <li>• Are young people <u>genuinely</u> involved in the decision making?</li> <li>• Is there sufficient financial support for the ongoing costs of the project post funding?</li> <li>• Can it be funded by an alternative grants programme?</li> </ul> <p>Local young people will also have involvement in the endorsement process through the existing Youth Opportunities Fund scrutiny panels. Additionally, advice will be sought from District and Borough Council officers, where necessary. Please aim to pass your myplace applications to HCC by <b>16<sup>th</sup> September 2008</b>, two weeks before the Big Lottery deadline of 30<sup>th</sup> September 2008.</p> <p>Hampshire County Council is eligible to apply to myplace and will be subject to the same scrutiny as other organisations.</p> <p>MCK explained that she is putting in a bid for youth provision and youth activities in Bridgemary and HCC have informed her that this is the only bid they would be willing to support at the moment.</p> <p>The group agreed to support the Bridgemary proposal and MCK agreed to put together a paper on this project which will be taken to the LSP meeting on 10<sup>th</sup> September requesting their support for the proposal</p>	<p><b>MCK/JD</b></p>
